

Personal Block

The use of personal blocks in our annual quilt show provides a for more of our members to have an entry. So often we as quilters have given away our larger quilts as gifts before our January show and that has reduced our number of entries. These small quilts provide an easy entry for **all** of our members. By the way; after the show you can trim your name from the top rebind the top and it's a little quilt you can give as a gift and don't forget it is "museum quality" to boot.

- The finished size is 12"X14", utilizing the top 2" for your name.
- Blocks must meet the current criterion, this year some red fabric must be used and the theme is holidays (either one on the standard calendar or your personal holiday.)
- Borders are not required but may be used if making a block that is less than 12 inches
- You may add embellishments of your choosing such as buttons, sequins, beads and embroidery
- You may use any method to complete the design (appliqué: fused, raw edge, embroidery, crayola, painted or pieced)
- To qualify as completed the project must have backing and batting, however as these are art you may use a stiffer batting (including "Tim-Tex") than usual. Also some form of finished edge other than surging or raw edge must be used.
- Your name: use your first name and first letter of your last name if multiple members have the same first name. If you choose to use your full name as well.
